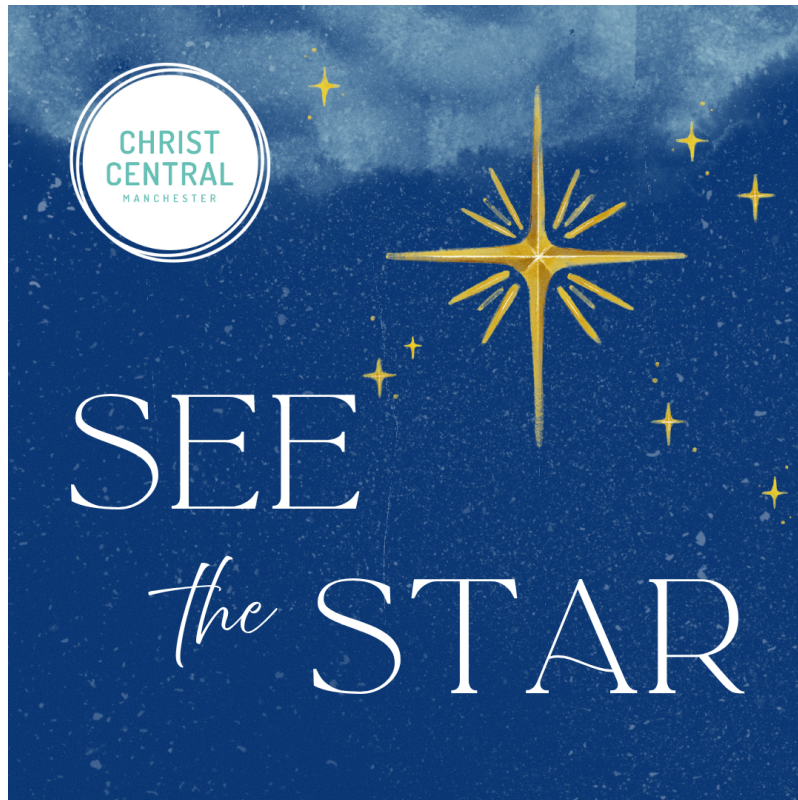


Hi All
